New Year Dharma Maha Sammelan, 2013

On this occasion a 72 hours Kiirtan program was started from 3 PM of 31st Dec, 12 and continued till 3 PM of 3rd Jan, 13 in front of DMS ground. At the end of this program Kiirtana Parikrama was held covering entire Central Ananda Nagar.
